BACK TO SCHOOL PROGRAM

Helping students to feel they fit-in & not stand-out.

"One mother (who has recently moved here due to domestic violence) cried and cried. They did not have the basics eg lunchbox, back pack etc as it was all left behind. She was really appreciative. The student came and showed me his new items and was so excited and was just like the other students. Another family has several children – they were really appreciative as they could go and buy them new underwear and socks. The students had outgrown the ones they had. All families were thrilled and the vouchers have made such a difference in a big way – confidence, feeling that they belong and socially. It has also taken the pressure off some families to get items that they had been putting off due to a lack of finances". Welfare Officer

"One young person supported this year has only recently been forced out of home. Whilst the school has been able to provide her with uniforms and basic stationery needs, the voucher will be used to purchase a backpack and some runners to help her participate in PE and sports activities. This helps her to feel less isolated within her cohort due to her lack of adequate means to provide for basic needs. She was delighted when given the voucher today". Principal
