## Future Leaders Scholarship 2017

The Alpine Valleys Community Leadership Program (AVCLP) is the preeminent Community Leadership Program of North East Victoria.

Commencing in July each year, a diverse group of up to 24 aspiring leaders embark on the 10 month intensive experiential learning program. The program is both challenging and inspiring. Graduates of the program will develop:

- Self awareness and leadership skills;
- Knowledge of, and appreciation for, North East Victoria and Border regions;
- A strong network of leadership and management contacts.

### Scholarship Includes

- 24 days, delivered one full day per fortnight at locations across the region;
- Program days examine challenges and opportunities in the region, showcase innovative projects and the leaders that drive them;
- Three overnight retreats with a focus on personal and leadership skills development;
- Study tours to Melbourne and Canberra to meet with State and Federal members.

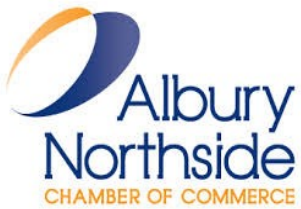
### Albury Northside Chamber Scholarship
