Helping Students in need to fit-in at the start of the school year
\$50 Target Vouchers - Total distribution \$253,650



“Two of our vouchers went to students from the same family who have experienced much sadness and ongoing worry recently. The mother was in tears when she thanked me, and said her younger child had been wearing shoes too tight for him for some time. Knowing the money issue, the child hardly complained, but was ecstatic that he could finally have shoes to fit.”

“A parent said, ‘You don’t know how much this means’ and cried. That indicated that the program is extremely worthwhile.” School Principal

“Last year, our school took Year 8 students on a 10 day camp. One student turned up without a bag or a change of clothes as she didn’t have anything to bring.
